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**LIMITED ASSURANCE REPORT

Scope:

We have been engaged by SAL Saudi Logistics Services Company (A Saudi Joint Stock Company) (the "Company") to perform a 'limited assurance engagement,' as defined by International Standards on Assurance Engagements endorsed in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, here after referred to as the engagement, to report on the Company's compliance with the requirements of Article (71) of the Companies' Law (the "Subject Matter"), contained in the Company's attached notification (Appendix 1) which is presented by the Company's Board of Directors (the "BOD") to the Ordinary General Assembly Meeting on the transactions and contracts in which a member of the Company's Board of Directors have a direct or indirect personal interest in them, dated 14 April 2026.

Criteria Applied by the Company:

In preparing the Subject Matter, the Company applied the below criteria (the "Criteria"). Such Criteria were specifically designed for the notification presented by the Company's Board of Directors to the Ordinary General Assembly Meeting (Appendix 1). As a result, the subject matter information may not be suitable for another purpose.

1. Article (71) of the Companies' Law issued by Ministry of Commerce ("MC") (1443H - 2022G).
2. Notification presented by the Company's BOD to the Ordinary General Assembly Meeting (Appendix 1) dated 14 April 2026.
3. Declarations submitted by the Company's Board of Directors' members regarding transactions and contracts in which some member of the Company's Board of Directors have a direct or indirect personal interest in them.

Company's Responsibilities:

The Company's management is responsible for selecting the Criteria, and for presenting the Subject Matter in accordance with that Criteria, in all material respects. This responsibility includes establishing and maintaining internal controls, maintaining adequate records and making estimates that are relevant to the preparation of the Subject Matter, such that it is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Our Responsibilities:

Our responsibility is to express a conclusion on the presentation of the Subject Matter based on the evidence we have obtained.

We conducted our engagement in accordance with the International Standard for *Assurance Engagements Other Than Audits or Reviews of Historical Financial Information* ("ISAE 3000") that is endorsed in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, and the terms of reference for this engagement as agreed with the Company on 14 April 2026. Those standards require that we plan and perform our engagement to express a conclusion on whether we are aware of any material modifications that need to be made to the Subject Matter in order for it to be in accordance with the Criteria, and to issue a report. The nature, timing, and extent of the procedures selected depend on our judgment, including an assessment of the risk of material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

We believe that the evidence obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our limited assurance conclusion.

Our Independence and Quality Management

We have maintained our independence and confirm that we have met the requirements of the International Code of Ethics for Professional Accountants (including International Independence Standards) that is endorsed in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, and have the required competencies and experience to conduct this assurance engagement.

Our firm also applies *International Standard on Quality Management 1, Quality Management for Firms that Perform Audits or Reviews of Financial Statements, or Other Assurance or Related Services Engagements*, that is endorsed in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, which requires that we design, implement, and operate a system of quality management including policies or procedures regarding compliance with ethical requirements, professional standards and applicable legal and regulatory requirements.

Description of procedures performed:

Procedures performed in a limited assurance engagement vary in nature and timing from, and are less in extent than for a reasonable assurance engagement. Consequently, the level of assurance obtained in a limited assurance engagement is substantially lower than the assurance that would have been obtained had a reasonable assurance engagement been performed. Our procedures were designed to obtain a limited level of assurance on which to base our conclusion and do not provide all the evidence that would be required to provide a reasonable level of assurance.

Although we considered the effectiveness of management's internal controls when determining the nature and extent of our procedures, our assurance engagement was not designed to provide assurance on internal controls. Our procedures did not include testing controls or performing procedures relating to checking aggregation or calculation of data within IT systems.

Description of procedures performed (continued):

- Discuss with the management the contracts and transactions between the Board of Directors' members either directly or indirectly with the Company during the year ended 31 December 2025.

We also performed such other procedures as we considered necessary in the circumstances.

Based on our review of the periodic reports presented to the Audit Committee by the Internal Audit, Risk Management, Governance and Compliance departments and external auditors during the year ended 31 December 2025, as well as our discussions with these parties, the Audit Committee concludes that the results did not reveal any significant gaps in the control environment of the company that may affect the soundness and effectiveness of governance, risk management, financial and operational control processes. The Audit Committee has not become aware of any situations that have affected or may affect, materially, the Company's financial performance. The Audit Committee has also noted no major failures on the part of Executive Management to address the audit findings and recommendations without adequate justification.
