Holding company activities (involving the acquisition and management of controlling interests in a group of subsidiaries, with a primary focus on ownership and strategic direction.) 3. Research and Development: Conducting research and development in the fields of engineering and technology. 4. Manufacturing Activities: Production of refined petroleum products. 5. Manufacturing of basic chemicals. 6. Production of other chemical products not classified elsewhere. 7. Conversion industries and related manufacturing operations. 8. Manufacturing of plastics and synthetic rubber in their primary forms. 9. Production of polyethylene. 10. <u>New Article</u>		<p>Article 9: Purchase, Sale, or Pledge of the Company's Shares</p> <p>Subject to a resolution by the Extraordinary General Assembly, the Company may issue preferred or regular shares and may purchase, sell, pledge, or transfer its own shares. Shares acquired by the Company shall not carry voting rights in shareholders' meetings. The Company may purchase its own shares as treasury shares or for the purpose of allocating them to its employees—or to employees of its subsidiaries—under an employee share program. Treasury shares may be sold in a single transaction or in multiple transactions, in accordance with applicable laws and regulations.</p>
