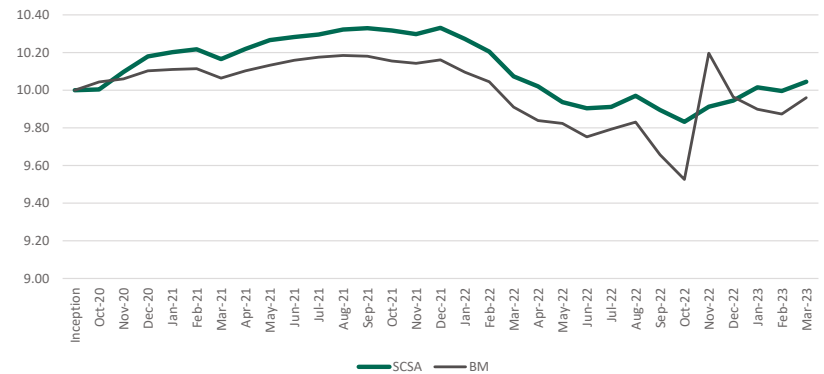

Manager Performance

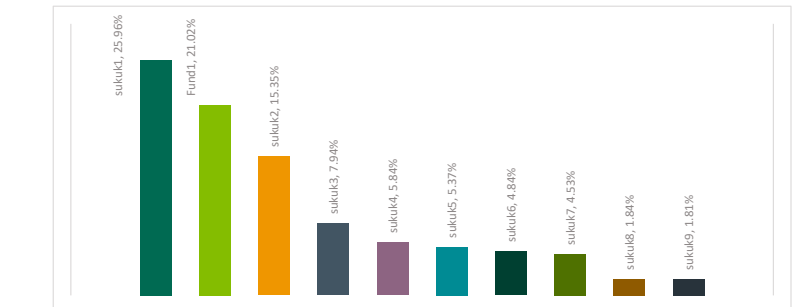
October 2020 - March 2023 (Single Computation)



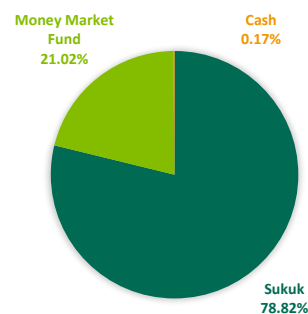
